
Dear Bill:

Please accept this letter as a statement of my support of the Hoshino Therapy office located at 145 Madeira Avenue, Suite 202 in Coral Gables, Florida.

I became acquainted with Mr. Bodhi Kocica, a practitioner of Hoshino Therapy, approximately a year and a half ago. A physical therapy patient requested an evaluation of the practice and its potential for decreasing recurrent dizziness and headaches. I have since had frequent encounters with Mr. Kocica, the massage therapist, who practices Hoshino Therapy, and his wife, who assists with office management.

The system of Hoshino Therapy is a highly refined form of massage that is applied at specific points on muscles, musculo-tendinous junctions, and tendons. The pressure is applied to help restore normal length, extensibility, and circulation, to the muscles for healing. The practice consists of a series of treatments over a time period of between two months and one year. The goal of the treatments is to return to normal, musculature that has been allowed to shorten; to heal tissue inflamed from overuse, and to correct posture.

I have been impressed with the results of Hoshino Therapy and have recommended patients to the clinic for care. The treatments and office management are of the quality I would expect in a medically-related center.
